## YEAR IN REVIEW

Two companies joined the Center in 2023, BeeCentral Technology and Lehr Labs, and three companies expanded to additional space: BeeCentral Technology, Envision Biomedical, and MRG Labs.

Over 250 individuals engaged with the Center's programs and initiatives in 2023, including students, community members and partners, and YCP faculty and staff.

The Center was renovated for the first time since opening in 2010. A fresh coat of paint, new flooring, and acoustic panels have given the on-campus facility a fresh, more inviting atmosphere.
