The position of Assistant Professor of Electrical Engineering is open for recruitment. An application for permanent labor certification will be filed with the Department of Labor. This Notice of Filing will be posted for ten (10) consecutive business days, ending between 30 and 180 days before filing the permanent labor certification application.

Job Duties: Tenure-track position in Electrical Engineering at the rank of Assistant Professor with primary expertise in the field of controls/automation and signal processing. Ability to teach a broad range of ECE courses including: Design & Analysis of Analog Circuits; Design & Analysis of Digital Circuits; Design & Analysis of Signals & Systems; Engineering Fundamentals, including chemistry, physics, and mathematics; Professional Engineering Issues; and Real-World Team Design Projects. The position is required to act as student advisor for this discipline. Other duties include engaging in ongoing scholarly and professional development. Will develop undergraduate laboratories and work with industry and students in applied research. Work hours will include teaching courses of 12 credits per semester with meeting times as assigned by the department chair and could include evening or Saturday classes; office hours of approximately one hour per day, scheduled throughout the week; and the Standard College work day of 8:30-5:00, Monday through Friday. Must have earned doctorate degree in Electrical Engineering or related field by December 2017; primary expertise in the field of electrical engineering and ability to teach a broad range of undergraduate ECE courses; experience in active learning pedagogies.


